

Woodstream HOA Pool Rules 2016

Please review this information with all members of your household and guests who will be using the community swimming pool and/or facilities to ensure compliance. We hope everyone will get a chance to enjoy the improvements to the pool, playground, and common use areas.

COBB COUNTY Pool Rules and Regulations are posted at the pool and must be adhered to. The following are especially important and must be complied with to prevent a Directed Pool Closure.

COMMON SENSE RULES FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL

1. No swimming alone.
2. **The Pool Enclosure Gate MUST remain closed after entry or exit at all times.** Visitors inside the fence must not open the gate for visitors who do not possess a key to enter.
3. No GLASS containers in pool enclosure or playground area.
4. Electrical cords are not permitted on the pool deck areas to prevent electrical/tripping hazards.
5. Keep food and drinks on tables provided around the pool deck.
6. No running or rough play around the pool deck. Be mindful of others in the pool.
7. No swimming allowed during heavy rain or stormy conditions where lightning is present.
8. Young children encouraged to use the restroom PRIOR to getting in the water.
9. Children 3 and under and those not yet potty trained, MUST use waterproof swim pants specially designed for this purpose.
10. All swimmers should shower before getting into the pool.
11. Properly dispose of all trash in cans provided.

ADDITIONAL POLICIES

1. In June 2011, the General Membership voted unanimously that Woodstream HOA Members who are not in good standing, do not qualify as guests and cannot use the pool.
2. Families wishing to invite guests to the pool are limited to **2 guests per household**. Any special requests, please contact secretary@woodstreamhoa.org.
3. Children 16 and older **may use the pool without supervision**. Children 15 and under require adult supervision. Adults must remain inside the pool enclosure to safely observe children in the pool. We recommend Basic First Aid, Pool Safety, and CPR training for anyone who will be supervising others at or around the pool. Adults will be responsible for knowing and abiding by all of the rules and policies. If a 16-18 year old child breaks any of the rules or policies, the parents or responsible adult member will be notified. If there is a 2nd warning regarding the same child, the child will not be allowed to use the pool without adult supervision for the rest of the pool season.
4. Smoking is only allowed (**age 18 and older**) where designated signs are posted. Please use ash cans and dispose of the filters before leaving.
5. **Any underage smoking, underage consumption of alcohol, or use of illegal drugs** will result in immediate notification of the police, and banning from the pool for the remainder of the season.
6. Children coming from the playground must rinse in the shower prior to entering the pool.
7. Profanity and intoxication will not be tolerated.
8. The phone provided at pool is for emergency use only.
9. Please close umbrellas when leaving the pool.
10. The parking lot will be locked at 10:00pm nightly.

POOL HOURS

8:00 AM TO 10:00 PM (All Swim) After Hours Swim - Adult Homeowners ONLY.

Please report any disturbance or illegal acts to Cobb County Police. Pool, playground, and pavilion areas are electronically monitored and images are provided to the local police for investigation purposes.
